

Coach Information Sheet

2010 Piedmont College High School Team Shootout
June 25-26, 2010



Registration – Johnny Mize Athletic Center Lobby:

Each team will be notified of its first game time as soon as possible prior to the start of camp. Boarding teams are encouraged to check-in at least an hour before their first game to get settled in the dorms. **Coaches need to turn in their players' payments, medical disclaimer forms, and dorm waiver forms (boarders only) upon arrival on campus.** No player will be permitted to play without a signed medical disclaimer and complete payment.

Check-Out:

Coaches will turn in all of their players' keys on the last day of camp (\$75 fee for all lost keys) to the concession stand in the Johnny Mize Athletic Center. Coaches will receive their stipend once their players' keys are turned in. Campers are responsible for the cleanliness and condition of their dorm rooms.

Coach's Package:

Each head coach will receive: \$50 stipend, access to the hospitality room (located in men's basketball locker room), t-shirt, lodging, and two meals.

Dorm Supervision:

Lights out time in the dorms is 11:30pm. There will be shootout staff members in the dorm; however, we would appreciate your assistance in helping to supervise your team.

Fundamental Session:

There will be an optional 45 minute fundamental session for players with the Piedmont coaching staff on Saturday morning. Limited sign-up will be Friday at dinner.

Meals:

Boarding teams and commuting teams with the meal option will receive two meals. The first meal will be dinner on the first day and the second will be lunch on the next day. More information will be provided at check-in.

Tentative Schedule:

Teams will play at least 5 games. The exact schedule will be provided at check-in and be posted at www.PiedmontLions.com.

Uniforms:

Teams need to bring a light and dark colored uniform. Numbers are not required.

Venues:

We will use two facilities for the shootout. The main gym will be the Johnny Mize Athletic Center on the campus of Piedmont College and the alternate gym will be at Habersham Ninth Grade Academy (2 miles from campus). Directions to NGA will be provided at check-in. If you haven't already, contact us as soon as possible if you do not have transportation to the alternate gym.
