### BS-MS SLP Integrated Program

As a CMSD major, you can apply to Piedmont University's integrated BS-MS Speech-Language Pathology program during the Fall of your junior year. You will take graduate coursework during your senior year at Piedmont University and transition directly into the master's program. You will graduate from Piedmont University with both a bachelor of science degree (BS) in communication sciences & disorders and a master's degree (MS) in speech-language pathology. You will be prepared to pass the Praxis exam for speech-language pathology and be ready for employment. Enrollment into graduate courses begins Fall 2023.
