

## Clery Act Annual Security and Fire Safety Report

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act, more commonly known as the Clery Act, requires colleges and universities to publish an annual report by October 1st that contains three years of campus crime and fire safety statistics and certain campus security policy statements including emergency notifications and timely warnings; procedures for reporting crimes; firearms and weapons policies; alcohol and drug policies; missing student notification procedures; and information about reporting sexual assaults, domestic violence, and dating violence.
